

SCHOOL LEAVER EMPLOYMENT SUPPORT (SLES) & CUSTOMISED EMPLOYMENT SUPPORT

Community Living & Respite Services (CLRS) is registered with the National Disability Insurance Agency (NDIA) to provide the School Leaver Employment Supports (SLES). Boosting the employment of people with disability is a strong vision of the NDIA and CLRS. We recognise that people with disability may need time and training to build successful long-term engagement with the world of work.

SLES is a specific approach for Year 12 school leavers and is designed to support your transition from school to employment.

We also offer a Customised Employment Service for non-school leavers and mature aged people.

We help people prepare, look for and gain employment. We work with you to provide valuable, individualised capacity building activities so you can achieve your employment goals. This may include supported volunteering at one of our Social Enterprises or work experience at a local business or community group.

As part of assisting to prepare you for employment we can:

- Develop an individual plan to support your unique pathway to employment
- Help foster partnerships and goodwill in the local community
- Use our extensive employer and professional networks and partnerships to develop innovative business practices to help you engage and connect with employers
