Our Social Enterprises operate all year round, and generally only close for Public Holidays. You can be involved any day of the week, and can take holidays when you choose.

When you volunteer with our social enterprises you receive training, invitations to CLRS staff and volunteer events and you will have the satisfaction of making a difference in our community.
