Run Echuca Moama Terms & Conditions

Run Echuca Moama (Event) is organised and delivered by Community Living & Respite Services Inc. (Event Organiser) (ABN: 44 201 747 656).

The Event will be held on Sunday 3rd August 2025. The Event includes the following individual events:

- 400m Junior Bolt
- 800m Junior Bolt
- 5km event
- 10km event
- 21.1 km/Half Marathon event

There is a time limit on completion each event as follows:

- 5km event = 2 hours
- 10km event = 2.5 hours
- 21.1 km/Half Marathon event = 3 hours

The Start Line will close at 9.45am.

The Finish Line will close at 11am.

Eligibility Requirements

Each entrant acknowledges that (to the extent permitted by law) they participate in the Event/s at their own risk and in consideration of, and as a condition of acceptance of, their entry into the Event/s each entrant agrees to release and indemnify (to the extent permitted by law) the Event Owner, the Event Organiser, the Event sponsors and each of their agents, affiliates, employees, members and volunteers ("those indemnified") from any and all liability (including without limitation liability in negligence) relating to an entrant's:

- i. death; or
- ii. illness; or
- iii. physical

or mental injury (including the aggravation, acceleration or reoccurrence of an injury), unless that death or injury was caused by the reckless conduct or reckless disregard of those indemnified.

Each entrant should seek medical advice to ensure they are fit to compete and this advice must be obtained regularly and with the specific demands of the Event/s in mind.

Each entrant recognises the difficulties of the Event/s and attests that they are physically fit to compete safely in the Event/s and that they have not been advised otherwise by a qualified medical practitioner.

If an entrant becomes aware of any medical condition or impairment that will be detrimental to their health if they participate in the Event/s, or are otherwise sick or injured prior to the Event/s, they must withdraw from the Event/s.

Each entrant consents to receive medical treatment that may be deemed advisable in the event of injury, accident and/or illness during the Physical Event. In the event of injury, accident and/or illness, costs of medical treatment and ambulance transportation are the responsibility of the entrant.

Each entrant must provide an emergency contact name and phone number and agrees that the Event Organiser or Event Owner may contact that person and exchange personal information with them in case of an emergency.

Entrants must ensure that their ability to participate in the Event/s is not significantly impaired by alcohol or drugs. Entrants must not behave in a manner that is offensive or aggressive, that may diminish the reputation of the Event/s (or of the Event Owner or Event Organiser) is contrary to law or is otherwise inappropriate. If the Event Owner or Event Organiser considers that an entrant breaches this clause, they may disqualify the entrant and direct the entrant to cease participation in the Event/s immediately and the entrant must comply.

Age Limits

All age limits are calculated on the date of the event.

The minimum and maximum ages for each event is as follows, as per guidance from Athletics Victoria

- Half Marathon must be aged 16 or older on the date of the event.
- 10km All children under the age of 13 years must be accompanied by an adult
- 5km All children under the age of 13 years must be accompanied by an adult
- 400m Junior Bolt Children between the ages of 5 & 7 years ONLY.
- 800m Junior Bolt Children between the ages of 8 & 10 years ONLY.

Parent or Guardian Permission

If a participant is under the age of 18, a parent or guardian must agree to all entry conditions on behalf of the participant.

Refusal of Participation

The Event Organiser reserves the right to refuse any application for entry into the Event for any reason, including where:

- An applicant does not meet the eligibility requirements
- An applicant does not meet the age limits for the nominated event;
- An application, including a team application, is not completed by the nominated completion date;
- the field cap has been reached, regardless of the circumstances; or
- An application is made on the Event Day unless the Event Organiser makes a specific exception allowing the application.

Cancellation Policy

In the event that the 2025 Run Echuca Moama cannot be held on Sunday 3rd August 2025 due to any circumstance, including but not limited to COVID-19 or flooding, participants will be provided with a choice of three options:

1. OPTION A: Enjoy automatic FREE transfer to the next alternatively scheduled event. (This option is the standard option unless you request Option B or C. Please note you will be automatically transferred to the next event if you take no action)

or

2. *OPTION B*: Enjoy a refund of 80% of your paid registration entry fee, no questions asked. (A 20% administration fee applies)

or

3. OPTION C: Donate 100% of your paid registration entry fee to our charity partner.

Entry Fees and Refunds

All entry fees include GST and are not tax deductable.

A refund of 80% of registration fees paid will be available for any withdrawals more than 30 days prior to the event date.

No refunds are available within 30 days prior to the event date.

Transfers and Resale

Event Transfers are permitted and must be completed through the Race Roster Event listing.

A \$10 administration fee will be applied to all transfers.

Refunds/credit notes cannot be issued for the difference in entry fee (if any) when downgrading your distance.

You must not offer your (or any other persons) Entry for sale through any medium, including auctions (on eBay or any other auctioning or similar means). All individuals involved in such conduct will be disqualified from the Event.

Conduct during the Event

Participants must follow the directions of course officials and marshals at all times. Failure to do so may result in immediate disqualification without the right of appeal or refund.

Participants consent to receive medical treatment which may be deemed advisable in the event of injury, accident and/or illness during the Event.

Participants, if supplied with a race bib, must always wear their race number bib on their front during their event.

Participants that Event Officials consider unlikely to reach the finish within the time limit detailed above may be directed to withdraw from the event. In these circumstances the

participant will voluntarily remove themselves from the course without liability to the Event Organiser.

Participants who fail to complete the course should report to event officials at the finish area or the closest aid station.

Animals and prams

No dogs are allowed on course or at event headquarters.

Prams are permitted in the Half Marathon, 10km and 5km events but must start at the rear of the field at the start line, take extreme care and be alert to other participants.

Future promotion

Following your participation in this event, we will publish results and use photographs, sound and video recordings taken of the event for promotional purposes. These will include the media, websites and social media along with other promotional channels.

If anyone attending the event does not want to be photographed please advise us at Race HQ on the day or via email with your bib number and name to <u>events@clrs.org.au</u>

You will be given a coloured wristband so photographers on the track can identify those who do not want photos taken.

If you do not wish to have your name published in results, please contact us via email and ensure that we acknowledge this request.

Privacy Statement: Information storage and use

The Event Organiser will collect and store the information you voluntarily provide to enable processing of registrations for the event, management of the event, to publish results and to provide you with information about this event. Third parties associated with the event may contact you for promotional purposes. Your information will not be provided to third parties not associated with the event.

Information will be provided to relevant staff and medical professionals where necessary.

You consent to these disclosures. Any information provided by you will be stored on a database that will only be accessed by authorised personnel and is subject to the National Privacy regulations.

Ambulance Cover
